Parents Code of Ethics

I hereby pledge to provide positive support, care, and encouragement for our child participating in Ashwaubenon Girls Softball Association, Inc. by following this PARENTS CODE of ETHICS PLEDGE. I further agree, acknowledge, and understand my position as a role model for my daughter, as well as others involved in Ashwaubenon Girls Softball Association, Inc., and accept this role along with all associated responsibilities.

1. I will encourage our daughters' participation in the summer softball league with Ashwaubenon Girls Softball Association, Inc.
2. I will remember that the game is for the children and not for the adults.
3. I will inform the coach of my daughters' team of any physical disability or ailment that may hinder my daughters play or may have an unsafe effect on my daughters playing of softball.
4. I will support officials and league administrators in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all and communicate requested information to the team coach.
5. I will learn the rules of the game, and the general policies of Ashwaubenon Girls Softball Association, Inc. If I have any questions, I will feel free to approach any Board Member from A.S.G.A., Inc.
6. I, and my guests, will be a positive influence and role models for my child and encourage good sportsmanship toward all players, coaches, umpires, and all other spectators at my daughters' games.
7. I, and my guests, will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike behavior toward any league official, umpire, coaches, or other parents, such as booing, taunting, using profane language, or gestures.
8. I will teach my daughter to play the game of softball by the rules of the league and to resolve any conflicts in a positive manner without any hostilities or violence.
9. I will teach my daughter to treat all other players, coaches, officials, and umpires with respect.
10. I will teach my daughter that doing your best is more important than winning the game.
11. I will praise my daughter for competing fairly and trying to do her best in all situations.
12. I will respect the coaches of my daughters' team and all other coaches in the league. I will respect the league officials of all leagues involved with AGSA, Inc.
13. If a problem were to arise with my daughters' coach, I will first approach the head coach of the team and address the issue in a mature, controlled fashion. If a satisfactory solution can not be resolved with a meeting with the head coach, I will then bring the issue to a Board Member of Ashwaubenon Girls Softball Association, Inc.
