**For Who:** 4K - 11<sup>th</sup> grades. **Girls accepted if 4 years old by 9/1/10.** 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> graders on the JV or Varsity teams are ineligible. **Only Ashwaubenon residents and non-resident students in Ashwaubenon public or private schools are eligible.**

1. You must register whether or not you were on a team last year. **EVERY girl will be on a team.** The enclosed registration form and emergency card must be signed by a parent.

**IMPORTANT: Uniform pants will be handed out for Little League (4<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> grade) and Babe Ruth (7<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup> grade) on registration nights. Those players should attend.**

2. **Registration fee** is paid at time of registration. Make checks payable to the **AGSA, Inc.**  
Pee-Wee League: Grades 4K-K      \$25. (Res), \$40. (Non-res) Will keep T-shirt  
Minor League; Grades 1-3      \$25. (Res), \$40. (Non-res) Will keep T-shirt  
Little League: Grades 4-6      \$30. (Res), \$45. (Non-res) Have umpires  
Babe Ruth League: Grades 7-11      \$30. (Res), \$45. (Non-res) Have umpires

3. **The maximum a family would pay for registration is \$60. (Res), or \$90. (Non-res).**

4. **Team Pictures:** Pictures will be \$10.00 at the time of registration, \$11.00 the day of team photos. A private party does this at a separate table. **Make check payable to Dennis Persick.**

5. **The Draft** for Babe Ruth & Little League will be held for all 4<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> graders, in addition to any new girls to AGSA in 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup> & 11<sup>th</sup> grades. All of these girls will participate in the draft evaluation which consists of fielding, throwing, batting & running. These girls will be drafted onto a team in either Little League for 4<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> graders, or Babe Ruth for 7<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup> graders. The girls will remain with these teams for the duration of years played in that league. The girls will be contacted one week prior to the draft with info on draft times. Girls who are in grades 3 or younger are placed on teams by the Pee-Wee & Minor League Presidents/Supervisors.

6. **All girls playing in Babe Ruth & Little League will be required to wear batting helmets with a face mask & chin strap on their helmets.** Each team will have helmets to share or the player may purchase their own. The team will supply bats but not gloves.

7. There will be an equipment swap table set up on registration night. See back of paper for info.
